SUBJECT: Disqualification Statement

This memorandum summarizes general areas or issues from which I am disqualified; it will be used to help screen matters before presentation to me. A final determination as to whether disqualification is necessary will be made in consultation with an ethics official (identified below).

I am disqualified from participating as Secretary in particular matters having a direct and predictable effect on the financial interests of PathAI, a company that makes medical diagnostic software, including matters affecting the company as a member of an industry sector or group.

Unless authorized by an ethics official, I am also disqualified for the following periods from participating as Secretary in a matter in which any of the following entities is a party or is representing a party:

one year from the date of my appointment

- State of Rhode Island

two years from the date of my appointment

- Democratic Governors Association
- Rhode Island Commerce Corporation
- Truth Initiative
- Yale Corporation (Yale University).

Matters from which I am disqualified will be referred to the Deputy Secretary or another official for action without my further involvement.
